
AIDex Australia Newsletter Nov 2021.

Hi all, thank you for your commitment to AIDex over the last year. We appreciate all those who have held us and those we minister to both in prayer and by generously giving to our ministry, it is truly appreciated. We have received our charity registrations and approvals here & in Kenya. This now allows donors to claim a tax deduction for donations to AIDex Australia INC. for donations over \$2. We have now opened a new bank account with Westpac. Name AIDex Australia Inc. BSB 033254 ACC 687763 (Please note this account for further donations). In Kenya, Ben & Benjamin have worked tirelessly to provide the uniforms (made in 2020) to our primary children. They were able to pay the secondary, technical and tertiary students fee's, supply face masks (made by our tailors), supply year 7 students with bibles, girls with hygiene kits & supply some medicines to those sick.



We have a desire to help those wanting theological help as God leads us and as people request our support. While 2020 has not been a strain on our finances due to there being very little schooling and hence no fee's to be paid, this year we are needing to pay two lots of school fee's (as the students do catchup schooling). We usually take on about 50 new children a year however due to the increased poverty experienced during Covid, we were asked to take on 366 new very vulnerable students this year by principals at schools. I'm not sure how we will go in the future supporting them all. We know God will provide. The heart collage above, is made up of these new children and we would like your financial help & prayers to ensure we can support them for the next 12 to 13 years of their schooling. 
