Praise God that we've been granted medical camp approval and currently have over 50 patients awaiting Dr Kenny's surgeries. We are really grateful for Dr Kenny's willingness to volunteer his time and donate medical supplies towards the camp.

POLYCARP update. Polycarp has been waiting for further complex medical surgeries. His 1st surgery was for fixing internal issues through your support for his benign tumour called Neurofibroma, (a malformation on his face that's been pressing on his brain). Polycarp & his father have been travelling to and from Nairobi, some 12 hrs by bus at least monthly since the op. We praise God that recently he was referred to a missions hospital in Kijabe (near Nairobi). He has just been given his next surgery date being 3rd June. Please pray that this 2nd op (we believe fixing external things) goes as well as can be expected. We understand that there might be a few other ops after this upcoming one.
