
AIDex Australia Newsletter May 2024.

Hi all, I hope you are well. Thank you for your Interest & commitment to AIDex and our ministry in Kenya. We truly appreciate all those who have supported us financially and prayerfully.

AIDex is 30 years old! In 1993-94 the late Barry Hughes started AIDex in Western Kenya. We as a family started in 2001 after his death. By Gods grace, together with your help and donations, we have been able to continue the ministry to the vulnerable there. In 5 weeks, we will be taking another team from Australia to join with our brothers and sisters in Kenya. It will be a large contingency this year. We plan to visit our students and widows and we have a huge medical camp planned, which we would love your financial help with. We would love to offer free medications to the sick coming to our medical camp. Our Australian team consists of Dr Kenny (surgeon), Matthew (chiropractor and laser treatment), Jess (physio in training), Gen, Anna, Judah, Joshua (our son), Di & myself. We have had many Kenyan medical people offer to volunteer at our camp this year. Most of these grew up around Samia, some were sponsored by us and this blesses my heart. One lady volunteering, a Dr Julia, a professor was the first female to serve as a member of the cabinet of the government of Kenya and first Kenyan woman to go to Harvard. We have a surgeon, some medical doctors, a pathologist, a sonographer, a nutritionist and a number of community health workers. We will be offering free minor surgeries and medical help. We have some 60 schools to visit and the younger ones in our team are taking the gospel to those schools through puppets, drama, song etc. Please keep us all in your prayers (see suggestions overpage).
